

I soon rescued a kitten from the Cat Haven once I left home and my love of cats began. I started breeding Birmans in the late 80's but then discovered Ragdolls and became one of the early pioneers of the breed.

It was on a trip to the US to buy a breeding pair of Ragdolls that I met Anne Baker, the Founder of the Ragdoll breed and also met my first Sphynx and my love took over for that breed as well. I pioneered the Sphynx breed in Australia and have taken it to where it is today together with the help of some very good breeders.

I am a qualified steward and took on my judging as I wanted to give back to the Cat Fancy, especially ANCATS the knowledge and joy it has given me. I am very proud to say that I am now an All-breeds Judge.
